RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF COLORADO, DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS FOR THE GRAY AND BLACK MARKET MARIJUANA ENFORCEMENT GRANT PROGRAM BY THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has applied for a grant from the State of Colorado, Department of Local Affairs, Gray and Black Market Marijuana Enforcement Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, these funds would support the El Paso County Strategic Plan's Goal #1 – Maintain and promote a financially sustainable County government that is transparent and effective, Goal #5 – Strive to ensure a safe, secure and healthy community; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds would support the Gray and Black Market Marijuana Enforcement and will be used toward the investigation and prosecution of unlicensed marijuana cultivation or distribution operations through year 2021.
