**RESOLUTION TO SET SALARY COMPENSATION FOR
EL PASO COUNTY CORONER, DR. LEON KELLY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. §§ 30-11-101(1)(e) and 30-11-107(1)(e), the Board of County Commissioners of El Paso County, Colorado (hereinafter "Board"), has the legislative authority to make such orders concerning the management and business of the County; and

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2018, Dr. Leon Kelly was elected as El Paso County Coroner, with all of the duties, rights, and benefits appurtenant thereto; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 30-2-102 provides for the Coroner to receive compensation for services of not less than one hundred twenty thousand four hundred eighty-five dollars and no cents (\$120,485.00) per annum; and

WHEREAS, the elected official Coroner salary listed in C.R.S. § 30-2-102 is a legal mandated salary; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 30-2-108 (d) provides in counties of every class, a board of county commissioners may provide for additional compensation to be paid to any coroner who performs a post-mortem examination of the body of a deceased person pursuant to C.R.S. § 30-10-606(2), which compensation shall be paid out of the county treasury; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his duties as Coroner, Dr. Leon Kelly is a Board Certified Forensic Pathologist who regularly performs post-mortem examinations pursuant to C.R.S. § 30-10-606(2); and

WHEREAS, the County has decided, pursuant to C.R.S. § 30-2-108 (d), that the County will pay an annual salary to Dr. Kelly for his performance of the post-mortem examinations in the sum of one hundred sixty-nine thousand five hundred and fifteen dollars and no cents (\$169,515.00); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of El Paso County, Colorado, hereby approves and authorizes, pursuant to C.R.S. § 30-2-108 (d), an annual salary for Dr. Leon Kelly of one hundred sixty-nine thousand five hundred and fifteen dollars and no cents (\$169,515.00) for post-mortem examinations commencing on January 1, 2021.


