BACKGROUND (including information on budgeted matters)

El Paso County has worked with VTI Security Integrators over the past several years to update and expand the County's surveillance cameras, door access systems, and other security system related items. An On-Call contract would allow VTI to respond faster to problems involving our surveillance camera or building access systems. This would help to prevent extended outages or public safety issues that can arise from a malfunctioning security system. An On-Call Contract will allow the County to utilize VTI's services for projects under \$200,000.00 per project.

This purchase will be completed using a Jefferson County Statement of Qualifications (Project # 005Z-FA). Jefferson County's SOQ contains piggyback language that allows El Paso County to utilize their solicitation and negotiate our own contract with the awarded vendor.
