WHEREAS, the Board, in its capacity as a duly elected decision-making body, may choose to take an official position of support or opposition on legislation introduced in the Colorado General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the Board previously provided direction to staff that they oppose SB23-169; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to ratify its direction by way of formal letter, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners, State of Colorado, County of El Paso, hereby officially opposes SB23-169.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board formally adopts the attached letter as its official position opposing SB23-169.
