BACKGROUND (including information on budgeted matters)

The Chafee Program provides support to foster teens and young adults aged 14 to 23 and to assist them in a successful transition to independent living. These services include providing assistance with problem solving, support and an essential connection with another person until they can develop a support system within their community.

The CFCIP Collaborative Services Plan includes how the program will identify and engage youth eligible for these services, how the program will design and deliver individualized services to achieve legal permanency and lifelong connections, wellbeing, safe and stable housing, secondary educational attainment, post-secondary training and educational attainment, adequate employment, financial stability, successful transition to adulthood from foster care, and sex trafficking reporting requirements
