## Proclamation Recognizing Foster, Kinship, and Adoptive Families

WHEREAS, all children deserve and benefit from enduring, positive relationships with caring

adults, especially when their own families are in crisis and unable to provide for their

essential well-being; and

WHEREAS, foster families, kinship families, and adoptive families and those who work with these families each have a dedicated month to highlight their commitment to the children in

WHEREAS, any given day, about 610 children are living in out-of-home care in El Paso County;

WHEREAS, the El Paso County Department of Human Services (DHS) placement team, on average, completes 88 placements of children, youths, and sibling groups each

month, with most searches successfully leading to placement with foster or kin; and

WHEREAS, DHS has completed 491 adoptions for children in foster care or kinship care over

the last five years and, of those, 226 were kin or kin-like adoptions; and

WHEREAS, the El Paso County Department of Human Services has a primary responsibility to assure the safety of children and to strengthen families, and improve the overall

quality of life in our community; and

WHEREAS, the immeasurable and ongoing gifts of time and caring given by kinship, foster, and adoptive families in El Paso County are greatly appreciated and deserve public

thanks.
