**Agenda Wording:** Resolution finding sufficiency of crime insurance policy coverage for elected and county officials.

#### SUMMARY (including information on budgeted matters)

The BOCC is required on the first day of each term to examine and inquire into the sufficiency of the official bonds of the County Treasurer, Sheriff, Coroner, Assessor, Clerk and Recorder, Surveyor and "all other official bonds given by any county officer" which latter category is inclusive of the County Commissioners, and to exercise such other and further powers as conferred by law.

Per Resolution No. 10-502, the County has elected to purchase crime insurance coverage for its elected and County officials in lieu of requiring them to post surety bonds to provide the appropriate protection for the public. The BOCC has received information from the County's Human Resources and Risk Management Department that the County's crime insurance policies and the endorsement thereto for its elected and County officials are valid and in full force and effect, is satisfied that the County's elected and County officials are in full compliance with the requirements of C.R.S. § 24-13-105, concerning the sufficiency of the crime insurance policy purchased to protect the interests of the public.
