Agenda Wording: Resolution for approval of an Intergovernmental Agreement for provision of burial and/or cremation of indigent or unclaimed remains.

SUMMARY (including information on budgeted matters)

The El Paso County Coroner's Office ("Coroner"), as the elected county coroner, is responsible for the body of a deceased person to be "decently buried," pursuant to C.R.S. § 30-10-618.

In accordance with C.R.S. § 15-19-106(5), a public administrator, "shall make arrangements for the final disposition of the decedents' remains" when the family of an indigent or unclaimed human body does not claim the remains or make arrangements for burial or when such family member cannot be reasonably ascertained.

The Board and the Coroner desire to enter into an agreement with the Public Administrator for the Fourth Judicial District of Colorado ("Public Administrator") to provide for the final disposition of decedent's remains when necessary pursuant to C.R.S. § 15-19-106(5), and as further described in the Intergovernmental Agreement for Provision of Burial and/or Cremation of Indigent or Unclaimed Remains ("IGA").
