This item is to request approval of Award of a Construction Contract to RMC Consultants, Inc. for the Fountain Creek Channel Stabilization at Riverside project for the Department of Public Works (Engineering Division) at a cost not to exceed \$2,765,347.50 (IFB# 19-015).

BACKGROUND (including information on budgeted matters)

Through a competitive Invitation for Bid (IFB) process advertised on November 28, 2018 six (6) bids were received on January 9, 2019. After going through a comprehensive review and clarifications process, it was determined that RMC Consultants, Inc. was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. Accordingly, the review team is recommending a contract award to RMC Consultants, Inc. The bids ranged in price from \$2,765,347.50 to \$4,616,575.50.

The Project is a Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funded project to realign and stabilize Fountain Creek near the El Paso County owned property (previously Riverside Mobile Home Park) in southern El Paso County. The Project is approximately 12 miles southeast of downtown Colorado Springs and the work area is located in Christian Open Space, about 300 feet north of Crest Drive bordered by Bandle Drive to the west. The work will generally consist of realigning and stabilizing approximately 2000 feet of Fountain Creek, constructing oxbow ponds, and restoring the confluence of West Bank Tributary as a result of the severe flooding that occurred September 9 through September 15, 2013 which ultimately led to the Presidential Disaster Declaration on September 14, 2013.

RMC Consultants, Inc. is located in Wheat Ridge, Colorado.
