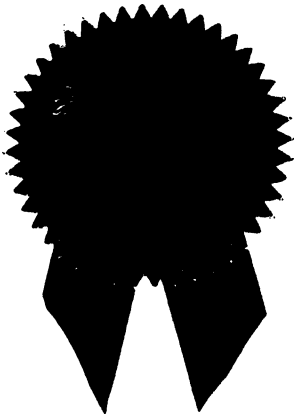


# Proclamation Recognizing the Retirement of Lynn Williams from El Paso County Public Works

- WHEREAS,** The Board of County Commissioners of El Paso County, Colorado, regrettfully acknowledges the retirement of Lynn Williams after 26 years serving in the Department of Public Works and the County Parks Department; and
- WHEREAS,** Mr. Williams was hired in May 1993 to work on the Highway Division's bridge crew where he worked for three years before accepting a position as an equipment operator in 1996 with El Paso County Parks; and
- WHEREAS,** In 1998, Mr. Williams was promoted to Operations Support foreman to direct a crew of equipment, operators and utility staff to oversee maintenance and new construction projects in the Parks department, constructing and maintaining trails, bridges, parking lots, roads, and parks facilities; and
- WHEREAS,** Mr. Williams was reassigned to the Penrose Equestrian Center in 1999 as Operations Foreman overseeing construction projects and coordinating events and event staff. Then in 2002 he accepted additional responsibilities at the Equestrian Center supporting the full time manager during temporary leave and continued operation of the facility in her absence before returning to his former position in the Parks Department almost a year later; and
- WHEREAS,** In 2007, Mr. Williams role was expanded. He took on the oversight of new projects and administrative duties, contract oversight, budget tracking for grants, projects, maintenance, FEMA reimbursements and regulatory compliance; and
- WHEREAS,** Mr. Williams sought a change in direction in 2014, returning to the Department of Public Works Highway Division and becoming a Grader Foreman. In that role, he managed the Urban Grader Team, serving the western half of the County maintaining gravel roads; and
- WHEREAS,** Mr. Williams' knowledge and service has contributed greatly to the ongoing success of the Departments of Public Works and El Paso County Parks and his expertise, commitment, experience and resourcefulness will be greatly missed by everyone in those departments and around the County.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Board of County Commissioners of El Paso County, Colorado, hereby proclaims its gratitude to Lynn Williams for 26 years of dedicated service.
